Halvard Buhaug serves as the Research Director and Research Professor at the Peace Research Institute Oslo (PRIO), and as a Professor of Political Science at the Norwegian University of Science and Technology (NTNU). Additionally, he is an Associate Editor for the Journal of Peace Research. His research, which focuses extensively on the security implications of climate change, has been supported by prestigious organizations such as the European Union, the World Bank, the US Department of Defense, the UN Office for the Coordination of Humanitarian Affairs, and the Research Council of Norway. Among his accolades, he was honored with the 2015 Karl Deutsch Award. He has also been the principal investigator for two ERC projects: a Consolidator Grant (2015-2021) and an Advanced Grant (2022-).
