Dominic Rohner is a Professor of Economics at the Geneva Graduate Institute. He holds a PhD in Economics from the University of Cambridge and is a Research Fellow at CEPR, CESifo, OxCarre, and HiCN. Renowned for his contributions to political and development economics, his research has earned several prestigious prizes. He has led an ERC-funded project titled "Policies for Peace" and currently serves as an Associate Editor at the Economic Journal. Additionally, he leads the CEPR Research and Policy Network on Preventing Conflict and is a member of the National Research Council of the Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF). He recently published a new book titled "The Peace Formula: Voice, Work and Warranties, not Violence."
